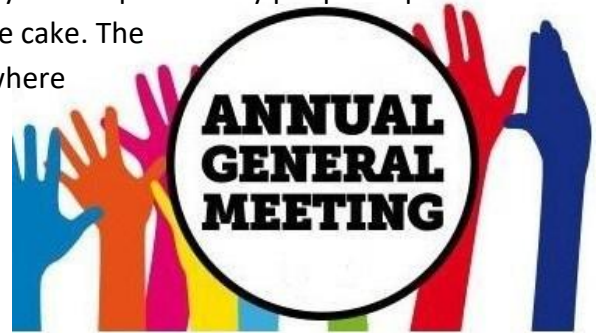


Cake anyone?
