Spring Plant Sale



Our spring plant sale was on Saturday 24th May. The four Deacons who organised it were worried that the long hot dry spring we have had would deter people from buying their bedding plants from us, because the garden centres and supermarkets had been selling bedding plants for several weeks. However, they needn't have worried as the turnout was steady all morning and even though they had doubled the number of plants they had previously sold, they were close to selling them all at the close of play. Selling continued after the 'official sale' was over as some people could not attend on the day. They made a total of £845 and 2 cents on the day and another £50 since. It has been the best total to date and the money will be used towards the ongoing chapel refurbishment.

We need to thank Mandi, Cathy, Lindsey and John who all put a huge amount of work in, but we would not have the number and range of plants without all those who grew plants or re-potted hundreds of plug plants

and nurtured them to maturity. Several people kindly donated plants they had raised from seeds or divided from their own gardens, which assisted towards the total on the day. We also need to thank those who worked the sale on the day. The setter uppers; the bakers; the washer uppers, the stall workers on the tombola, the raffle and the tea and cakes, and the plant sellers. It was a fantastic joint effort.

Finally, we would like to thank everyone who came and purchased plants, cakes and tickets on the day. It's your attendance that makes the hard work beforehand worthwhile.
